**WirelessGate to Sell Prepaid SIM Card Enabling
the Use of LTE, 3G and Wi-Fi Services to Foreign
Visitors in Japan**

Sales to Start at Yodobashi Camera Stores Tomorrow

WirelessGate, Inc. (Head Office: Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and CEO: Takehiro Ikeda; hereinafter "WirelessGate"), a wireless broadband service provider, will start selling the Wireless Prepaid SIM, a prepaid SIM card that can be used on Xi™ (LTE) and FOMA^R (W-CDMA) networks provided by NTT DOCOMO, INC. and at about 40,000 WirelessGate Wi-Fi wireless LAN service locations nationwide, to foreign visitors in Japan, a demographic that is expected to grow in the future.

[Highly convenient communication service that takes into account what foreign visitors in Japan need]

The Wireless Prepaid SIM is a prepaid SIM card that makes wireless communication in Japan possible on SIM-free terminals owned by foreign visitors in Japan, such as smartphones and tablets. This card offers a highly convenient service to foreign visitors by enabling them to use wireless LAN locations they frequent, such as airports, major train stations, bullet trains and coffee shops, in addition to LTE and 3G networks usable in wide areas, including in vehicles on the move. WirelessGate has prepared a free dedicated application so that people who have difficulty setting up access to the Internet can effortlessly use this card. Wireless Prepaid SIM holders can easily manage both setups and controls on this application, including an automatic switch between Wi-Fi and LTE connection.

[SIM card enabling each store to customize service plans]

The Wireless Prepaid SIM is a SIM card that can be sold after customizing the service name, service details, rate plans and similar features for each sales channel. The stores of consumer electronics retailer Yodobashi Camera will be the first group of sales outlets that will offer the Wireless Prepaid SIM. The card will go on sale at the Yodobashi Camera stores and the retailer's online shopping site [Yodobashi.com \(http://www.yodobashi.com/\)](http://www.yodobashi.com/) on December 19, 2014. Yodobashi Camera will offer three Wireless Prepaid SIM plans, including a plan availing a maximum communication speed of 150Mbps and a maximum data capacity of 1GB for 2,980 yen. WirelessGate plans to proactively establish sales channels highly convenient to foreign visitors in Japan, such as hotels, restaurants, public facilities and websites, irrespective of business lines and industries, in a bid to popularize this SIM card.

WirelessGate will keep expanding and upgrading its services to offer a comfortable broadband communication environment, not only for people in Japan but also for foreign visitors in the country at all times.
